

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS &  
SAFETY  
VALPARAISO, INDIANA  
OCTOBER 11, 2006**

The Board of Public Works & Safety of Valparaiso, Indiana, met on October 11, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. Present were Clerk-Treasurer Sharon Swihart and members Mayor Jon Costas and John Hardwick. Dave Pilz was absent. Mayor Costas called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

John Hardwick moved that minutes of the September 28, 2006 meeting be approved as presented, seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved. John Hardwick moved that claims be approved for payment subject to appropriation balances, seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved.

**EXCESS EQUIPMENT SALE**

Bill Oeding asked for approval to include parking meters in the excess equipment that was approved for sale. John Hardwick moved to deem the meters as excess equipment and to approve sale, seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved.

**TRAFFIC & SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS**

Tim Burkman presented the Traffic & Safety Committees recommendations to post NO PARKING signs along the inside curves of the Streamwood Subdivision on Glenalyn Drive, Stori Lane, Taylor Lane and Aldi Lane and to change the NO PARKING restriction along Franklin Street between Billings Street and Evans Avenue from the west side of the street to the east side of the street. John Hardwick moved to approve the recommendations, seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved.

Atty. Dave Hollenbeck advised that the closing on the purchase of the new police station building would be Friday afternoon. The appropriation problem was taken care of with the help of Sharon Swihart.

Tim Burkman advised that the Vale Park extension is expected to be done around the first week in November. The first two layers of the paving are down. He is hoping that the traffic signals will be in yet in October.
