

**ORDINANCE NO. 7 - 2016**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO, INDIANA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20-2015 ENTITLED "CITY OF VALPARAISO 2016 SALARY ORDINANCE"**

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2015, , the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana ("Council"), adopted Ordinance No. 20-2015 entitled "City of Valparaiso 2015 Salary Ordinance"; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 20-2015 established the salaries and other compensation to be paid to employees of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana ("City") in 2016; and

WHEREAS, it was recently discovered that Exhibit "G" was mistakenly omitted from Ordinance No. 20-2015; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit "G" establishes the amount of the City's annual contribution towards City employees' health saving account health insurance programs in 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Council is desirous of amending Ordinance No. 20-2015 in order to add Exhibit "G" in order to establish the amount of the City's contribution towards City employees' health savings account health insurance programs in 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO, INDIANA, THAT ORDINANCE NO. 20-2015 SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Exhibit "G" is hereby added to Ordinance No. 20-2015 which shall read as follows:

**EXHIBIT G: HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNT CONTRIBUTIONS**

I. Health Savings Account Contributions

City employees previously enrolled or enrolling in the following health savings account health insurance programs will receive a contribution from the City to be paid into each such employee's account as follows:

<u>HSA Program</u>	<u>Total Contribution</u>
Employee Only:	\$1,600.00
Employee Plus One:	\$2,800.00
Family:	\$3,600.00

The above-referenced contribution will be paid by the City into each employee's account in January.


New City employees that begin working for the City in 2016 and subsequently enroll in the health savings account health insurance program will receive a prorated contribution from the City to be paid into each employee's account. The prorated contribution shall be determined based upon the employee's first full month of employment with the City.

BE IT ORDAINED THAT, if any portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other portion or provision of this Ordinance.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED THAT, all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. It is provided, however, that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency, and in all other respects the ordinances or parts of ordinances are hereby ratified, re-established and confirmed.

This Ordinance shall be full force and effect from and after its adoption and the procedures required by law.


