August 12, 2016

The Board of Public Works & Safety of Valparaiso, Indiana met on August 12, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in City Hall. Present were Bill Oeding, Matt Murphy and Attorney Ethan Lowe. Bill Oeding called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Washington Street Roadway and Utility Improvement Project

Tim Burkman received and opened bids for the Washington Street Roadway and Utility Improvement Project. The bids are under advisement until the August 26, 2016 Board of Works meeting. This project was designed in house and the Engineering Estimate was \$620,000.00. The bids are as follows:
