

ORDINANCE #22, 2018

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONEY RECEIVED FROM PARKING SOURCES OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2019

SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, that for the expenses of the Parking Meter Department for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2019, the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws governing same.
