

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY
VALPARAISO, INDIANA
December 28, 2018**

The Board of Public Works & Safety of Valparaiso, Indiana met December 28, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. in City Hall. Present were Mayor Costas and Bill Oeding. Mayor Costas called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Costas moved that the minutes of the December 14, 2018 meeting be approved, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

No claims were presented.

Downtown Temporary Parking Signs

At the north west corner of Lincolnway and Washington, by Gil Drugs, there is a "12 Minute Only" parking sign. This sign has been up for quite some time, but it does not appear to have been approved by the Board of Works. Adam McAlpine requested approval of this sign. He also requested approval to put up a similar sign at the north west corner of Indiana and Washington Streets and the South East corner of Lincolnway and Napoleon.

Mayor Costas moved to approve the request with the sign to be noticeable, to indicate what it is intended for – pick-up/delivery, to be for a time of 15 minutes and to be in affect 24/7. Seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

Dangerous Intersection Signs – CR 500 and CR 600

Adam McAlpine advised he has been contacted by INDOT. They would like the "Dangerous Intersection Ahead" signs to be removed on CR 500 and CR 600. The State will replace the signs with new ones that will have wording they want.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Bill Oeding and so approved.

Expansion of Chicago Commuter Bus Service

Stu Summers requested approval to seek proposals for options to expand the Chicago Commuter Bus Service. Options appear to be to add another coach bus for DASH and connect to the South Shore service.

Mayor Costas moved to approve with instructions to proceed right away with the purchase of the fifth bus for DASH and at the same time, request bids on proposals to expand the service. Bill Oeding seconded and so approved.

There was no further business and the meeting was adjourned.
