**WHEREAS**, the City of Valparaiso prides itself on the high-quality public schools afforded our city, which boosts the overall quality of life, economic development and future of our children; and


**WHEREAS**, the fiscal strength of our public schools if threatened, impedes student achievement, overall success of our city and the gainful employment of the hundreds of public school employees;



Adopted this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 2019 by a vote of all members present and voting.


