

ORDINANCE 32, 2007
AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS IN
THE GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to transfer funds in the General Fund:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, that for expenses within the budget of the General Fund the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and transferred into the accounts herein named for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws governing same:

Interest on Tax Warrants	101012381	\$ 50,000
Buildings & Structures	101012361	\$ 25,000

Total \$154,000.00

WHEREAS, it has been shown that certain existing appropriations now have unobligated balances that will not be needed for the purposes for which appropriated, it is further ordained that the following existing appropriations be reduced in the following amounts:


Board of Public Works & Safety

Salaries & Wages	101012111	\$ 20,000
Police & Fire Pension	101012122	\$ 45,000
PERF	101012123	\$ 25,000
Insurance	101012342	\$ 10,000
Health Insurance	101012125	\$ 54,000

Total \$154,000.00

The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.


