

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY
VALPARAISO, INDIANA
July 12, 2019**

The Board of Public Works & Safety of Valparaiso, Indiana met July 12, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. in City Hall. Present were Mayor Costas and Steve Poulos. Mayor Costas called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Costas moved that the minutes of the June 28, 2019 meeting be approved, seconded by Steve Poulos and so approved.

Mayor Costas moved that the claims be approved for payment and subject to appropriation balances, seconded by Mayor Costas and so approved.

3609 Campbell Easements

Lauren Orchard requested approval of a sidewalk and utility easement at 3609 Campbell. This is a missing link between two pathways. The RDC has approved construction of this pathway.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Steve Poulos and so approved.

Token Transit

Don Lorntzen requested approval of the contract with Token Transit. This is for the Dash and V-Line mobile apps and the validation system.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Steve Poulos and so approved.

Banta Neighborhood Sign Topper

Maggie Clifton requested approval of the locations for sign toppers created by the Banta Neighborhood Association. These toppers will go on 21 street signs and 4 will be held on to as replacements.

Mayor Costas moved to approve, seconded by Steve Poulos and so approved.

Froberg Road Closure

Nate McGinley requested approval of closing Froberg Road August 5th and 6th. He presented a proposed detour route. Olthof Homes is requesting this closure to put in a storm sewer as part of Pepper Cove.

Napoleon & Lincolnway Parking

Nate McGinley requested approval to paint and stripe the parking space formerly at the northwest corner of Napoleon and Lincolnway. Trucks were having an issue turning so the first parking spot at this corner was marked off. People are parking there anyway. Issuing tickets has become an issue.

Pepper Cove Maintenance Surety

Easement for 504 Roosevelt Road Pathway
