

ORDINANCE 29, 2003

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS IN
THE GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to transfer funds in the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, that for expenses within the budget of the General Fund the following sum of money is hereby appropriated and transferred into the accounts herein named for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws governing same:


GENERAL FUND

PLAN COMMISSION BZA/Plan Commission Members	\$ 900
PLAN COMMISSION Postage	\$ 1,000


WHEREAS, it has been shown that certain existing appropriations now have unobligated balances that will not be needed for the purposes for which appropriated, it is further ordained that the following existing appropriations be reduced in the following amounts:

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY Capital Outlays	\$100,000
PLAN COMMISSION Travel/Education	\$ 1,900

The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

PASSED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, on the 28 day of July, 2003 by a 6-0 vote of 6 members present and voting.


