

ORDINANCE 39, 2003

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS IN
THE PARK AND RECREATION AND GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to transfer funds in the Park & Recreation and General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, that for expenses within the budget of the Park & Recreation Fund and the General Fund, the following sum of money is hereby appropriated and transferred into the accounts herein named for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws governing same:

PARK & RECREATION FUND

Park & Recreation
Personal Services \$ 10,000

GENERAL FUND

City Planner
Personal Services \$ 5,500

WHEREAS, it has been shown that certain existing appropriations now have unobligated balances that will not be needed for the purposes for which appropriated, it is further ordained that the following existing appropriations be reduced in the following amounts:

PARK & RECREATION FUND



Travel/Ed \$ 600


