

ORDINANCE 33, 2002
AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS IN THE GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to transfer funds in the General Fund:

101005361 Repair & Maintenance – Equipment \$ 18,000



101005111 Salaries & Wages \$ 18,000


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

PASSED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana on the 28th day of October, 2002 by a 6-0 vote of 6 members present and voting.


