

ORDINANCE 41, 2002

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS IN THE PARK & RECREATION FUND

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to transfer funds in the Park & Recreation Fund:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, that for expenses within the budget of the Park & Recreation Fund the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and transferred into the accounts herein named for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws governing same:


PARK DEPARTMENT
Personal Services \$ 40,000



Capital Outlays \$ 40,000


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

PASSED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana on the 9th day of Dec, 2002 by a 7-0 vote of 7 members present and voting.


