

ORDINANCE NO. 19, 2000

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A COMPENSATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND PROVIDING FOR ADMINISTRATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Common Council, Mayor, Clerk Treasurer have determined that it is appropriate that the prior job Classification Ordinance of the City be modified to provide for a new Compensation Management System; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Common Council to provide for a Compensation Management System that provides for equal treatment of all City employees in various job classifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso as follows:


1. The Chapter 25 of the Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

Chapter 25
Compensation Management System


