

ORDINANCE NO. 41, 2000

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to transfer funds within the General fund:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, that for expenses within the budget of the General Fund the following sum of money is hereby transferred into the accounts herein named for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws governing same:

WHEREAS, it has shown that certain existing appropriations now have unobligated balances that will not be needed for the purposes for which appropriated, it is further ordained that the following existing appropriations be reduced in the following amounts:

Garage & motor 101006221 \$15,000.00
