

ORDINANCE 48, 2000

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONEY RECEIVED FROM THE PARKING METERS OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO, INDIANA, AND OTHER PARKING SOURCES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2001, INCLUDING CLAIMS AND OBLIGATIONS AND FIXING A TIME WHEN THE SAME SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, that for the expenses of the Parking Meter Department for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2001, the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws all expenditures authorized to be made during the year unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided by law.

SECTION 2: That for said fiscal year there is hereby appropriated out of the "Parking Meter Fund" of said City, the following:






