A speaker will be given a reasonable amount of time (as determined by the Mayor) to make a comment and/or express an opinion. No person will be recognized more than once per meeting. Absent permission from the Mayor, all speakers must remain at the podium. Any speaker that engages in personal attacks and/or acts in an uncivil manner will be stopped and may be prohibited from future opportunities to publicly address the Council. The Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer, City Council members, and City staff are available after the meeting for questions and more extended discussions.
