ORDINANCE NO. 26-2019

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A WATER FEE OR PAYMENT IN LIEU OF PROPERTY TAXES APPLICABLE TO CERTAIN CUSTOMERS OF THE DAMON RUN WATER WORKS SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Damon Run Conservancy District ("Damon Run") owns a water utility system (the "Damon Run System") that provides water utility service to customers located both inside and outside of its service territory; and

WHEREAS, Damon Run has an agreement with Indiana-American Water Company ("IAWC") to operate and maintain Damon Run's water facilities and provide a source of water supply for Damon Run's customers and, in exchange, IAWC directly bills Damon Run's water customers at IAWC's regular, retail water rates; and

WHEREAS, Damon Run imposes monthly user fees and taxes on customers within its service territory to, among other things, meet Damon Run's operational needs and to make principal and interest payments on Damon run's outstanding bonds; and

WHEREAS, Damon Run provides water utility service to certain customers located outside of its service territory (the "Outside Territory Customers"), pursuant to special contracts ("Service Agreements"); and

WHEREAS, the Service Agreements provide for the Outside Territory Customers to pay a monthly user fee (i.e. payment in lieu of taxes or "PILOT"), which is intended to ensure that the Outside Territory Customers pay an amount proportionate to the taxes paid by customers inside of Damon Run's service territory; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with a sale of all its sewer assets, Damon Run also agreed to assign the Service Agreements for the Outside Territory Customers to the Valparaiso City Utilities (the "Utility") and the City of Valparaiso, Indiana (the "City"), and VCU has, in turn, agreed to collect the PILOTs from the Outside Territory Customers on behalf of Damon Run; and

WHEREAS, the accounting firm of Baker Tilly Municipal Advisors, LLC, a financial advisor to the City, has prepared a rate report (the "Report") establishing a recommended PILOT for the Outside Territory Customers, and the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana (the "Common Council"), has reviewed the Report; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council finds that the PILOT as set forth herein is consistent with the Service Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the VCU has recommended to the Common Council that this Ordinance be adopted and the PILOT set forth herein be established for the Outside Territory Customers; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has caused notice of the public hearing on the PILOT to be duly advertised and has held a public hearing thereon, all pursuant to Ind. Code § 8-1.5-3-8.1.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO, INDIANA, that a PILOT shall be established for the Outside Territory Customers as follows:

Section 1. Definitions. The following definitions shall apply to this Ordinance:

- (A) <u>Outside Territory Customers</u>. The term "Outside Territory Customers" means those properties and premises that are connected to and served by the Damon Run System but are located outside of its service territory. The term includes all properties and premises that are currently connected to the system or that are connected in the future.
- (B) <u>Equivalent Dwelling Unit ("EDU")</u>. The Term equivalent dwelling unit or EDU means the equivalent of a single-family residential dwelling unit calculated as follows:

Annual flow for the most recent 12 month period (in gallons)	XXX
Divided by days of the year	<u> 365</u>

Section 2. PILOT. There is established a monthly PILOT applicable to the Outside Territory Customers in the amount as presented on Exhibit A to be adjusted annually for the "true-up" defined below. The number of EDUs applicable to each Outside Territory Customer shall be determined according to the terms of such customer's Service Agreement as defined above. The amount of the PILOT shall be "trued-up" or adjusted each year to ensure that the Outside Territory Customers are paying an amount consistent with the Service Agreements and the ongoing needs of Damon Run.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Existing Rates and Charges.</u> This Ordinance is only intended to establish PILOTs for Damon Run's outside territory customers. Unless specifically amended by this Ordinance, all other City water rates, charges, and provisions related thereto shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Classification of Rates and Charges</u>. The PILOTs set forth herein will not be imposed based on whether the customer in question is inside or outside the City limits, but rather will be based on whether the customer will be served by the distinct and separate Damon Run water facilities. Other than the Outside Territory Customers, the City and VCU do not collect PILOTs from any other customers.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Repeal of Prior Ordinances.</u> All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed. The provisions of the Rate Ordinances not specifically amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Severability of Provisions</u>. In the event any one or more of the provisions contained in this Ordinance should be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein shall not, in any way, be affected or impaired and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage; however, the PILOT provided herein will not be implemented until the day that Damon Run, VCU, and the City close on the sale of Damon Run's sewer system and assignment of the Service Agreements. The closing is currently scheduled for December 2, 2019.
