AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE AND ESTABLISH THE FIRE FIGHTING FUND

WHEREAS the Valparaiso Common Council has determined that the City of Valparaiso's Firefighter Training and Firefighter Equipment fund(s) established under Ordinance No. 12-2002 under Municipal Code Chapter 94, Section(s) 94.040, 94.075, 94.130, 94.165 and 94.999 are no longer needed and shall be eliminated; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined the establishment of a singular Firefighting Fund will prove beneficial to the city; and the Firefighting Fund will serve as recipient of funds collected and received by the City of Valparaiso and it's Fire Department under Municipal Code Chapter 94, Section(s) 94.040, 94.075, 94.130, 94.165 and 94.999; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED THAT, at the time of the establishment of the Firefighting Fund all existing funds in the Firefighter Training and Firefighting Equipment funds will be rolled into the Firefighting Fund; and

- 1) It has been determined that after all costs associated with the performance of the Firefighting Fund have been satisfied; 85% of said remaining funds collected will be deposited in the City of Valparaiso General Fund and the remaining 15% of collected funds shall remain in said Firefighting Fund
- 2) It has been determined that the Chief of the Fire Department and/or his/her designee(s) shall be named and have said authority for the collection, allocation and expenditure of all costs associated with the performance of said Firefighting Fund.
