ORDINANCE 29, 2005

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 94, SECTION 40 FIRE INSPECTION FEES OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, has determined that it is in the best interests of the City that fire inspections be performed for all businesses within the City; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 12-2002 was adopted on May 13, 2002 to update the local fire prevention code and implement Fire Inspection Fees; and

WHEREAS, the State of Indiana under IC 36-8-17-8 requires a regular Inspection program and maintenance of written reports; and;

WHEREAS, the existing ordinance does not differentiate between the size of mercantile businesses and said inspection fees; and

WHEREAS, Section 94.040 Inspection Fees, Item (7) M Class shall be amended as follows:

(7) M Class, \$75, mercantile 2501 square feet and above; \$50, mercantile 2500 square feet and below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso that Chapter 94, Section 40 of the Municipal Code of the City of Valparaiso be amended and listed below:

94.40 INSPECTION FEES

(A) Fire Inspections shall be performed for all new businesses and current businesses at an annual rate based on Occupancy as follows:

(1)	A Class	\$75	50 or more people;
(2)	B Class	\$40	49 or less people;
(3)	E Class	\$60	Schools; Day Care;
(4)	F Class	\$100	Manufacturing, Industry;
(5)	H Class	\$125	Hazardous;
(6)	I Class	\$100	Health Care Facilities;
(7)	M Class	\$75	Mercantile – 2501 sq feet and above;
	M Class	\$50	Mercantile – 2500 sq feet and below
(8)	R Class	\$60	Residential; Apartments; Hotels;
(9)	S Class	\$60	Storage;
(10)	U Class	\$20	Garages; Sheds;

(B) The above fees do not reflect any fines or penalties associated with inspections found to be in violation.
