## ORDINANCE 3, 2004

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONEY RECEIVED FROM THE PARKING METERS OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO, INDIANA, AND OTHER PARKING SOURCES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2004, INCLUDING CLAIMS AND OBLIGATIONS AND FIXING A TIME WHEN THE SAME SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, that for the expenses of the Parking Meter Department for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2004, the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified subject to the laws governing same.

SECTION 2: That for said fiscal year there is hereby appropriated out of the "Parking Meter Fund" of said City, the following:

SECTION 3: Hearing for remonstrance and objections by taxpayers provided for in Section 2 hereof shall be and the same is hereby set for the February 09, 2004 meeting of the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, in the City Hall of said City.

SECTION 4: After such hearing held in accordance with such notices as herein provided, said Council shall by Ordinance confirm or disaffirm its said determination heretofore made and in the event that said determination is confirmed, the City Clerk-Treasurer is ordered to file a transcript of all proceedings herein as required by law with the Department of Local Government Finance.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage in the manner provided by law.
