RESOLUTION NO.12-2007

A Resolution granting approval for Additional Homestead Credits For Valparaiso Homesteads

WHEREAS, the CITY has expanded its geographic area by 23% through annexation; and

WHEREAS, as of January 01, 2007, the CITY has provided services to the annexation area; and

WHEREAS, the CITY will not receive tax revenue from the annexation until 2008; and

WHEREAS, the city successfully received authorization from the Department of Local Government Finance to receive excess levy to fund city services in the annexation area; and

WHEREAS, the CITY desires to provide services to the annexation area and expand the CITY'S tax base at no additional expense to current City home owners; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 1478 (2007) and subsequent codified versions, allows a political subdivision to adopt a resolution after December 31, 2006, and before June 1, 2007, to provide for the use of revenue for the purpose of providing a homestead credit under IC 6-1.1-20.4 in 2007;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Common Council of the City of Valparaiso hereby allocates \$325,000 from Economic Development Income Tax revenue to be applied in 2007 by Porter County Government to current home owners of Valparaiso who have homestead credit exemptions on file with Porter County Government. This action by the Common Council is based upon authority given to them by the Indiana General Assembly and the City's desire to apply that authority for the benefit of Valparaiso's current home owners.
