RESOLUTION #8, 2005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLERK-TREASURER TO REQUEST A LOAN FROM THE REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION FOR VARIOUS FUNDS IN ANTICIPATION OF TAXES TO BE RECEIVED.

WHEREAS, the Motor Vehicle Highway Fund, the Park & Recreation Fund, the Corporation Bond & Interest Fund, the Park Bond & Interest Fund, the Fire Pension Fund and the Police Pension Fund all receive monies from property taxes levied, and

WHEREAS, because of a delay in certifications, the Porter County Treasurer has been unable to send property tax bills to citizens for the usual May 10 deadline and anticipates that bills will be mailed with a deadline for payment of June 3, 2005, and

WHEREAS, because of this delay final tax settlement will not be received until sometime in late July or early August, causing serious cash flow problems in the various funds above mentioned,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso that the Clerk-Treasurer be authorized to request a temporary loan from the Redevelopment Commission in an amount not to exceed \$1,473,000, to be distributed as follows:
