## **RESOLUTION #10, 2005**

## AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN IN THE CITY OF VALPARAISO, INDIANA

WHEREAS, in May of 2001, a Comprehensive Plan was adopted by the City of Valparaiso; and

WHEREAS, in April of 2003, an amendment was adopted to the City's Comprehensive Plan;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code §36-7-4-503(2)(M) provisions concerning "parks and recreation, including parks, playgrounds, reservations, forest, wild life refuge and other public places of a recreational nature" can be made part of a Comprehensive Plan;

WHEREAS, the City of Valparaiso Parks and Recreations Board has adopted the Valparaiso Pathways and Greenways Master Plan and that it is the opinion of the Plan Commission that such should be placed into the City's Comprehensive Plan;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code §36-7-4-511, each amendment to the Comprehensive Plan must be approved according to the procedures set forth under Indiana law;

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2005, the Valparaiso Plan Commission approved, with a favorable recommendation, amendment to the Comprehensive Plan so that the *Valparaiso Pathway and Greenway Master Plan* will be incorporated into the overall Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, upon favorable recommendation by the Valparaiso Plan Commission, amends the Comprehensive Plan to include the Valparaiso Pathway and Greenway Master Plan.
