

RESOLUTION #25, 2011

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALPARAISO, INDIANA, ADOPTING THE US HIGHWAY 30 CORRIDOR PLAN AS AN ADDENDUM TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Valparaiso, Indiana's ("City") current Comprehensive Plan and Growth Management Plan were adopted by the Common Council of the City in the form of Ordinances 22-2003 and 2-2000 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the City has undertaken the process to review and revise its current Comprehensive Plan and Growth Management Plan in the form of the proposed EnVision Valparaiso 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to enhance the visual quality, access and safety of the US 30/Morthland Drive corridor as an addendum to the current and future Comprehensive Plans, the City has developed a US Highway 30 Corridor Plan which will serve as a guide for future development and other improvements within the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the US Highway 30 Corridor Plan has been developed pursuant to Indiana Code IC 36-7-4-500 Series Comprehensive Plans and the Corridor Plan is hereby incorporated by reference into this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, extensive discussions were held with the general public and other interested parties concerning the proposed US Highway 30 Corridor Plan and a formal public hearing was held by the City's Plan Commission on July 12, 2011 as part of the process of developing the plan; and

WHEREAS, following the aforementioned public hearing, the City of Valparaiso, Indiana, Plan Commission voted to recommend the approval of the US Highway 30 Corridor Plan and officially certify its decision to the Common Council of the City by a 7-0 vote on July 25, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Porter County, Indiana, as follows:

1. The City of Valparaiso's US Highway 30 Corridor Plan is hereby adopted as an addendum to the current Comprehensive Plan and future EnVision Valparaiso 2030 Comprehensive Plan.
