The City of Valparaiso has announced a city-wide drive-through Food Drive to benefit Hilltop Neighborhood House Food Pantry, announced Valparaiso Mayor Matt Murphy. “We’re so encouraged by the generosity of our community, giving blood, checking on neighbors, delivering meals. This Food Drive is another way we can support each other,” said Murphy.

The drive-through Food Drive will be held on Saturday, May 9, from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at the Butterfield Pavilion, 600 Evans Ave. in Valparaiso. Donations should be bagged/boxed so that volunteers can unload the contributions.
