- ☐ Items must be no more than 4-foot length and 3-inch diameter, and may not exceed 50 lbs.
- ☐ Brush and leaf piles must be separate
- ☐ Too heavy (cannot exceed 50 lbs.)
- ☐ Contractor generated debris the City will not clean up or pick up any form of yard waste, construction and demolition debris, or refuse left on a property by a contractor or their agent. (Ord. 53.24)

#### **ACCEPTABLE Yard Waste Items:**

- Leaves
- Straw (not hay)
- Garden and household plants
- Limbs, logs, firewood, brush and branches (no longer than 6-foot long and no bigger than 48-inch diameter)
- Live holiday decorations (pumpkins, corn, gourds, mums, live Christmas trees)
- Grass clippings (ONLY Valparaiso city residents)

### **Important Notes:**

- NO lumber or treated wood accepted; if it is not listed above, it is not accepted
- Plastic bags or containers must be removed by residents
- No rakes, shovels, or any other equipment or tools are available to residents

## **Acceptable Household Items:**

Batteries, electronics, fluorescent & LED bulbs, toner, smoke detectors, plastic bags, books, household recyclables
